Learning Goals

Language Arts- Our letter focus this week will be letter Aa. We will be revisiting writing this letter but learning the sound too. Our sight words are the words "the" and "at." We will do various activities with both letter and the sight words. We will continue focusing on concepts of print and segmenting initial, medial and final sounds in words. We will also continue to work on SPACES!

Math- We will continue to learn about 3D shapes. We will discuss the difference of 2D and 3D. We will experiment and decide what 3D shapes roll, stack and slide.
